be discontinued



The Approval to Construct and Operate Drainage Works on the Water Security Agency's Online Products Portal will be discontinued as of June 15, 2023

- After June 15th, QPs will need to obtain the Provincial Drainage Number from the WSA Approvals Technologist they are working with on the drainage project.
- QPs will submit the Network Boundary Shapefile to their WSA Approvals Technologist, and the Technologist will obtain the Provincial Drainage Number from WSA's Senior Geomatics Technician.



Improvements to the Drainage Application — please download and use the most recent version of the Drainage Works Application and Approval Form, which can be found in the Forms for QPs section of the WSA's Qualified Persons Webpage.

Updates include:

- We added some additional text to Section 5 (Declaration of QP) of the Drainage Application. The additional text is to remind QPs that they should be signing Section 5 after they have collected all the required signatures, land control documents, sanctions, etc. on the WSA reviewed application.
- We revised the names in the Manager pull down menu on the ATC/ATO, and AHPP. WSA's Nipawin office has a new Approvals North Manager. Andre Bishko has retired, and the new Approvals North Manager, is Sheldon Ofukany.

Improvements to ADAM - FlySask Imagery is now available to sign in to on ADAM

• ADAM has new FlySask imagery. This imagery consists of significant coverage of 30 cm imagery from 2022, as well as some additional coverage from 2021 and earlier that was missing from our collection. We've also added the "Pictometry" imagery, which is very high-resolution imagery coverage for cities. All the FlySask imagery is now being streamed directly from the hosting company, so new imagery will be viewable as soon as it's published, on an ongoing basis.

To sign in to the imagery: after you Logon to ADAM, a new "Sign in to access this site" pop-up window will appear at the top of the screen (see screen shots to the right of this column). So, please use the following Username and **ADAM** Password to sign in to FlySask: Username: ADAM App Password: AxF246D4GFFg Once you've signed in, the imagery can then be turned-on Sign in to access this site by clicking on the "+" sign beside the "FlySask2 Images" ization required by https://www.flysask2.ca layer grouping in the Layers tab (as shown in the second ADAM, App. screen capture below), then checking-on the imagery you AxF246D4GFFg would like to view. The "FlySask2 Ortho Images" is a mosaic of the most recent imagery for any given area. There are also individual layers for specific imagery epochs if you would like to view older imagery that is overwritten in the mosaic of most recent imagery. If you ever have problems with your ADAM account or the ADAM app isn't working properly, please reach out to your WSA Tech New "Wetland and Wetland and Drainage Calculator **Drainage Calculator**" One of WSA's Approvals Technologists created an Excel spreadsheet, called the "Wetland and Drainage Calculator". **Spreadsheet** This spreadsheet has automated the calculation of wetland drainage by wetland type. You will want to use this spreadsheet when you are filling in the Extent of Surface Drainage on the Risk Framework Worksheet and/or Section 4.1 of the Drainage Application and Approval Form. ADAM Mapping Course – This course is designed to ensure QPs know and use WSA's mapping protocol, procedures and app when completing drainage applications.

Point of Adequate Outlet Course - The purpose of this course is to provide participants with an understanding of key technical concepts required to determine the Point of Adequate Outlet.

The dates that the Point of Adequate Outlet (PAO) course is being offered include:

- June 1, 2023 one day in-person PAO refresher course in Cut Knife, SK (intended for people who have taken the PAO course before).
