

Agricultural Water Management Demonstration Projects

- WSA acknowledges that drainage has impacts (economics, hydrology, water quality, habitat and GHG management).
- To properly address these impacts, we need to understand the magnitude of these impacts, and what types of tools can be applied in a Saskatchewan context.
